When attending SOBC youth events in the Oasis or in the community, the undersigned student agrees to abide by the following guidelines. The undersigned parents/guardians acknowledge these expectations and agree to assist SOBC youth leaders in helping your student to abide by the expectations.

- 1. One's words should be encouraging to others and honoring to Christ, so no profanity, crudeness, gossip, disrespectful speech, or talking while someone is teaching or talking to the whole group.
- 2. One's clothing should not distract others from the message of the meetings, so nothing profane or immodest should be worn. Please note especially that young ladies (and guys too...) should not wear bikinis for water-related events.
- 3. One's actions should not be harmful to self or others, so no smoking, alcohol, drugs, or weapons.
- 4. One's behavior should not be isolating, so no hanging out in the parking lot, listening to music devices, playing handheld video games, or excessive use of cell phones. Do not have phones out for any reason during lesson/teaching times!!!
- 5. One's dating relationship should not have public displays of affection while with the youth group. The occasional side hug is fine, but no kissing, constant handholding, affectionate touching, etc. The goal again is not to distract yourself, your significant other, or the people around you.
- 6. The church's facility and people belong to God, so treat everything and everyone accordingly.
