## Handling Intimidation to Vision

"When all our enemies heard this, all the surrounding nations were intimidated and lost their confidence, for they realized that this task had been accomplished by our God." Nehemiah 6:16

## Pushing through intimidation will require that you...

1) Seek strength through prayer (vs. 1-9)

A. Another prayer of Nehemiah that shows his constant reliance on God.

B. We must continue to pray through any intimidating factors that would try to keep us from fulfilling God's will.

2) Stand your ground (10-11)

A. Nehemiah stood firm and did not cave into any threats to his own life.

B. Though Satan has come to steal, kill, and to destroy (John 10:10), the Bible reminds you that "Greater is He who is in you than he who is in this world." (1 John 4:4)

3) Sense the reality of the situation through spiritual discernment (12-14)

A. Nehemiah saw and understood that God had not sent Shemaiah. God gave Nehemiah discernment.B. God will also give you discernment as you seek to fulfill His will.

4) See the victory that God provides (15-18, Chapter 7)
A. The people were able to rebuild the wall in 52 days. This led to the intimidation shifting away from the people of Judah to the surrounding nations.
B. God will always lead you to victory as we follow His direction.
