- 1. _____ who Christ really is (vs. 9:18-20)
 - A. The most important question that you can ever answer - for the here and now and for your future - is who is Jesus Christ.
 - B. Many today are saying the same things about Jesus that the people in Luke's day were saying.
 - C. Peter correctly called Jesus the "Christ." This is the greek term for the hebrew word "Messiah." It means anointed one and savior.
- 2. Study His _____ (vs. 9:23-27)
 - A. Jesus told his disciples not to tell anyone yet that he was the messiah because it would have led to the cross too soon.
 - B. The work of Christ in the Gospel is clearly shown in this passage that Christ would die and be raised on the third day.
- 3. Submit to His _____ (vs. 9:23-27)
 - A. Discipleship, as Jesus defines it, requires three things:
 - 1. Denying yourself
 - 2. Taking up your cross daily
 - 3. Following Him.
 - B. Submission is an unconditional surrender of all that you are to Jesus.
