- - A. Believers should maintain an abiding relationship with Jesus so that we can stand before Him unashamed when he returns. (See also John 15:1-11)
 - B. John also uses the word "Confident" when referring to our standing before Jesus at his return.
 - i. "But in this letter, as in the letter to the Hebrews (4:16; 10:19), the word indicates the confidence with which the Christian may draw near to God in prayer now (3:21; 5:14), at the parousia [return of Christ] (2:28) and on the judgment day (4:17). It is only if we continue in him today, however, that we shall be confident before him and not shrink from him on the last day." (John R. W. Stott, The Letters of John: An Introduction and Commentary, vol. 19)
