

## **Finding Rest in Jesus**

### **John 11:25-30**

**Context** - The Pharisees had laid a heavy yoke on people. Forcing a legalism to the law that was impossible to carry. Jesus is presenting to the world a far easier road to salvation - in fact the only road to salvation and rest - Himself!

**Main Idea - *Jesus Christ is the authority and source for rest for the soul.***

**For the rest you seek...**

**1. \_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus (vs. 25-28a)**

But who exactly is this Jesus? This passage tells us quite a lot:

**He is the Son of God** - The second member of the Holy Trinity of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

**He is in full authority over all things** - This authority has been handed to Him by the Father.

**2. \_\_\_\_\_ Your Burdens onto him (vs. 28b)**

**Weary** - Greek word Kopto - To be tired from hard work. To lose heart. To experience suffering and fatigue.

**Burdened** - Heavy Laden. Like a ship with too much cargo. It is sunk low in the water and moving very slowly.

**3. \_\_\_\_\_ out his Work (vs. 29a)**

Take my yoke upon you means to get to work. To get to His work.

**4. \_\_\_\_\_ his teachings (vs. 29b-30)**

Jesus says, Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me (11:29a-b). This means "become My disciple," which includes learning, submitting, and obeying.

1 John 5:3 (HCSB)

***3For this is what love for God is: to keep His commands. Now His commands are not a burden,***
