Open It

What is the best gift you have ever received?

Explore It

How did God demonstrate His love for the world? (3:16)

Why is the word “for” at the beginning of John 3:16 so important?

Why did God send His Son into the world? (3:17)

How does the person who lives by truth respond to the light? (3:19-21)

Get It

In what ways might John 3:16 change how you view and respond to sin in your own life?

How has the gift of Jesus changed both your life and your eternity?

How is the death of Jesus a direct result of God’s love for us?

How does God’s gift of His Son affect our lives?

What does *condemned* mean? What does it mean not to be condemned?

What reasons do you have for confidence in God’s love?

How can a person live by the light?

Apply It

In the midst of trouble, on what encouraging truth from this passage will you rely?

Because of your restored relationship with the Father, what can you ask Him to give to you in Jesus’ name?

Do you feel no condemnation through Christ? How can you remind yourself and other believers that there is no condemnation for those in Christ?

What grief or sorrow do you need to entrust to God?
