

Few subjects are more intriguing and interesting than the subject of heaven. Questions explode from our minds as we think about it:

- 1) Where is heaven?
- 2) Does heaven really exist?
- 3) What does heaven look like?
- 4) Who will be in heaven?
- 5) Who won't be in heaven?
- 6) How can I be sure I will go there when I die?
- 7) What will we do in heaven?

All of these are excellent questions, but it is especially the last one, "What will we do in heaven?" that is the focus of Revelation 4:1-11. In this chapter we discover that heaven is not floating on a cotton candy cloud strumming a harp; it is not an eternal vacation that soon grows boring; nor is it an eternal sexual marathon as an exalted male procreates with his multitude of wives (Mormonism); neither is it an everlasting orgy of wine and women as taught in Islam.

No, our activity in heaven can be described and summed up in one word: worship. Worship of our great God is what heaven is all about, and worship is what we will do. For eternity we will see and be with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and for eternity we will give our worship to our God for: 1) who He is and 2) what He has done.

Following John's introductory vision of the risen and glorified Christ and his messages to the seven churches in 1:9-3:22, the scene shifts from earth to heaven in 4:1. This throne-room vision of Revelation 4–5 anchors the rest of the book. This vision first presents God as the sovereign Creator seated on his throne (4:1-11) before turning to Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, as the only one worthy to open the seals (5:1–14).

The throne image unites Revelation 4–5 as a grand assurance to God's people that he will accomplish his plans for creation. The only proper response is worship, first by the four living creatures (4:8), then by the twenty-four elders (4:10-11), then by all the angelic beings (5:8-12), and finally by every creature (5:13).

Revelation 4:1-2 (CSB) After this I looked, and there in heaven was an open door. The first voice that I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this." Immediately I was in the Spirit, and there was a throne in heaven and someone was seated on it.

Revelation 4:3-4 (CSB) The one seated there had the appearance of jasper and carnelian stone. A rainbow that had the appearance of an emerald surrounded the throne. Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones sat twenty-four elders dressed in white clothes, with golden crowns on their heads.

Revelation 4:5-6 (CSB) Flashes of lightning and rumblings and peals of thunder came from the throne. Seven fiery torches were burning before the throne, which are the seven spirits of God. Something like a sea of glass, similar to crystal, was also before the throne. Four living creatures covered with eyes in front and in back were around the throne on each side.

Revelation 4:7–8 (CSB) The first living creature was like a lion; the second living creature was like an ox; the third living creature had a face like a man; and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle. Each of the four living creatures had six wings; they were covered with eyes around and inside. Day and night they never stop, saying, Holy, holy, Lord God, the Almighty, who was, who is, and who is to come.



After this – after the vision of chapter 1 and the letters to the 7 churches in chapters 2 and 3, the scene changes. John, who is on Patmos, a penal colony and rock quarry for Roman prisoners, is suddenly shown a new vision and in a new location.



Revelation 4:1 (CSB) After this I looked, and there in heaven was an open door...

Heaven – This is where God reigns and angels

worship. It is the place to which Paul was raptured in 2 Cor. 12:2-4 where he writes, "I was caught up to the third heaven ... into Paradise." John also heard a voice in heaven sounding forth the clarion call and authority of a trumpet. It was the voice he heard in 1:10, it is the voice of Jesus.


Revelation 4:1 (CSB) ... The first voice that I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this."

This statement is crucial and looks back to the divine outline of the book in 1:19. John has recorded what he has seen, the vision of Christ in chapter 1. He wrote concerning the things which are, the 7 churches in his day of chapters 2 and 3. Now he writes about the things which will take place after these things, the events of chapters 4 - 22.

Revelation 4:1 (CSB) ... The first voice that I had heard speaking to me like a trumpet said, "Come up here, and I will show you what must take place after this." These chapters constitute the 3rd and final section of the book and describe what will happen at the end of history leading into eternity. That these events were future to John there is no question.

Here are some reasons why we see these chapters as future:

- 1) the catastrophic descriptions of the chapters portray events that have not yet been witnessed on the earth.
- 2) the close parallels to Daniel 7 and 9, Matthew 24 and 2 Thessalonians 2, all of which address the end of history



No, the scene shifts both to heaven (mentioned 50 times in Revelation) and the future as God lays out for us His purpose, His plan, for the consummation of history. Things will not unfold haphazard. There is purpose in God's plan. History is not aimlessly moving forward out of control. There is purpose in God's plan.

Immediately I was in the Spirit - 4 times the Spirit enraptures John (1:10; 17:13; 21:10) and moves him to an ecstatic vision. Perhaps John had returned to a normal state of consciousness, but with heaven's door opening, the voice like a trumpet and the Spirit seizing him he now experiences a fresh, new wave of ecstasy that carries him into heaven itself.

Immediately I was in the Spirit - John ascends to heaven by means of a Spirit-inspired vision, a prophetic experience similar to that of Ezekiel (e.g., Ezek. 3:14; 8:3; 11:1, 24). John immediately lays eyes on the center of all reality: God seated on his throne (cf. Isa. 6:1–4).




A throne in heaven. Revelation is a throne book and Revelation 4 is a throne chapter. The word throne occurs at least 45 times in Revelation as a whole and 14 times in chapter 4. It denotes monarchy, majesty, authority, royalty, and sovereignty.

The one on the throne is king and he sits continually as sovereign Lord. Earthly monarchs, rulers and presidents come and go, but this one remains forever. As Isaiah 6:1 says, "I saw the Lord sitting upon a throne high and lifted up." Psalm 47:8 adds, "God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne." In heaven, no one doubts who is in control. His authority is sovereign.

jasper – probably refers to a translucent rock crystal (cf. 21:11), perhaps a diamond. It pictures God's glory and purity.

carnelian stone - a blood red stone, pictures both the wrath of God poured out (14:20) and the blood of Christ that purchased our redemption (19:13).


Revelation 4:3 (CSB) The one seated there had the appearance of jasper and carnelian stone. A rainbow that had the appearance of an emerald surrounded the throne.

Rainbow – pictures God's covenant to Noah (Gen. 9:16-17) and his faithfulness to keep His word.

Emerald – green, pictures life, even mercy as our God is the God of new life and new beginnings

Revelation 4:3 (CSB) The one seated there had the appearance of jasper and carnelian stone. A rainbow that had the appearance of an emerald surrounded the throne.

Taken as a whole these precious stones portray God in all His majestic splendor and glory. He is awesome, magnificent, transcendent and spectacular.







Revelation 4:4 (CSB) Around the throne were twenty-four thrones, and on the thrones sat twenty-four elders dressed in white clothes, with golden crowns on their heads.

Encircling God's throne are 24 thrones occupied by 24 elders (presbuteros). Who are they? 1) angels; 2) Representatives of the redeemed of all the ages. (12 Tribes of Israel and 12 Apostles)

## Why the redeemed? 3 reasons:

- 1) Their chair they are on thrones (cf. Matt. 19:28; Rev. 3:21; 20:4).
- 2) Their clothes white, symbolic in Revelation of the purity and righteous acts of the saints (3:4-5, 18; 6:11; 7:9, 13-14; 19:8).
- 3) Their crowns (stephanos) are victors crowns (cf. 2:10) which are appropriate for the redeemed, not angels.

Lightnings, rumblings ("sounds") and thunder speak of the awesome power and strength that emanates from God's throne. It reminds us of God coming down at Mt. Sinai in Exodus 19:16. But these things also meant then what they mean now: a storm; and in Revelation, a storm of God's judgment.

In Revelation 8:5 they follow the breaking of the 7th seal; in 11:19 the blowing of the 7th trumpet and in 16:18 the pouring out of the 7th bowl. In 10:4, 7 thunders are about to come forth, but in mercy God seals them up.

In awesome strength God will judge this rebellious and sinful world, and each time He does His glorious power and strength will be revealed.

seven – perfect torches – light, sight burning – active in performing their function fully 7 spirits – perfect Holy Spirit

The perfect light bearing Spirit who convicts us of our sin is the same Spirit who is forever blazing before the throne in heaven. He is perfect in His person, perfect in his position and perfect in His performance



## Some believe it represents:

1) There is no more need for cleansing from sin in heaven. 2) God's transcendence, holiness and his unapproachability. 3) In mirror-like reflection the fact that all is revealed to God.










## HOLY, HOLY, HOLY IS THE LORD GOD ALMIGHTY



Shown here are two depictions of creatures known as *lamassu* that guarded the entrance to rooms in the Assyrian king's palace at Nimrud (865-860 BC). Both have wings and a human face. One has the body of a lion, the other has the body of a bull.



Revelation 4:6 ... Four living creatures covered with eyes in front and in back were around the throne on each side.

Four living creatures (zoa) — angelic beings of worship. Appearance of Ezekiel's cheribum (Ezk. 1:5-25; 10:1-22). Activity of Isaiah's seraphim (Isa. 6:2-3).

Revelation 4:6 ... Four living creatures covered with eyes in front and in back were around the throne on each side.

Eyes in front and back – emphasizes full knowledge, alertness and wisdom. Adrian Rogers calls them "God's cheerleaders!"

Revelation 4:7 (CSB) The first living creature was like a lion;

Lion – Emblematic of God's authority. The lion is the king of the animal world and represents strength, honor. That which is noble, respected. It was the mightiest among the wild animals. Revelation 4:7 ...the second living creature was like an ox...

Ox – Emblematic of God's activity. The ox denotes a character of service, strength, great power exercised for the benefit of others. It was the mightiest among the domesticated animals.

Revelation 4:7 ...the third living creature had a face like a man...

Man – The man is emblematic of God's majesty.

Man is the pinnacle of creation, and only man has a "face" in this vision. He is intellectual, intelligent, rational and spiritual. He is the mightiest of all that God made. He is God's vice – regent on earth.

Revelation 4:7 ...and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle.

Eagle – The eagle soars in the heavens and often represented deity. It is the mightiest among the birds and the swiftest of God's creatures.

These creatures are strong like a lion, serve like an ox, see like a man and are swift like an eagle. Each in its particular appearance gives witness to the greatness and glory of our God. No creature is as strong as He. No creature serves as does He. No creature sees as does He. No creature is as swift as is He!

Revelation 4:8 (CSB) Each of the four living creatures had six wings; they were covered with eyes around and inside. Day and night they never stop, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God, the Almighty, who was, who is, and who is to come.

Six wings – service

Eyes full – great knowledge with understanding

(searching)

Night and day – ceaselessly! They are sleepless angels! Holy, Holy, Holy – superlative attribution, implicit of the Trinity (cf. Isa. 6:2-3), a slight modification of Isa. 6.

Revelation 4:8 ...Day and night they never stop, saying, Holy, holy, Lord God, the Almighty, who was, who is, and who is to come.

Lord God Almighty – used only of God by Jewish and Christian writers. Sovereign Lord (cf. 1:8). Found 10 times in the New Testament, 9 in Revelation

(except II Cor. 6:18, which quotes the Old Testament). He is of unlimited power and might. Nothing is beyond His control.

Revelation 4:8 ...Day and night they never stop, saying, Holy, holy, Lord God, the Almighty, who was, who is, and who is to come.

Who was and is and is to come – looks to the I AM of Ex. 3:14. The Lord of creation is the Lord of the ages.

Beasley-Murray, "The future is characterized by His coming" (p. 118). This is the theme of the remainder of Revelation.

Revelation 4:10 (CSB) the twenty-four elders fall down before the one seated on the throne and worship the one who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne and say,

What He gives them they give back! They acknowledge that all they have is because of Him. Nothing they have would they withhold from Him.

The elders now join the living creatures in praising God. Here the word "worship" (proskyneō) suggests the common Eastern custom of prostrating oneself before a deity to show honor and respect. They submit their delegated authority to God in the act of laying their crowns before him. Their praise contrasts sharply with the worship of the emperor cult.


You are worthy – "taken from the political language of the day ... greeted the entrance of the emperor in triumphal procession" (Mounce, 140). For the Christian, only one is worthy, and He does not live on earth right now!


You are worthy – The title "Our Lord and God" (Latin: dominus et deus noster) demanded by Emperor Domitian is now rightfully applied to God, who alone is deserving of worship. God is specifically worshiped as Creator (4:11). The one who created this world is also its rightful Ruler.


God willed it and it happened. God spoke it and it was so. Such a God is worthy of our praise. Such a God is worthy of our worship.


## Key Themes of Revelation 4:1–11

- God is firmly seated on his throne as the sovereign Ruler of the universe.
- God's eternal greatness stands in contrast to the temporary, counterfeit powers of earthly pagan rulers.
- God alone is worthy of worship as the holy, powerful, eternal Creator.
- The chief activity of heaven is worship.










## Old Testament Connections
