Hebrews 10:19-25

Context - Christ has sacrificed His life once and for all (Hebrews 10:10, 12, 14) for our sins and given us full forgiveness - which in turn gives us the confidence to walk in full obedience.

Main Idea - Because of Jesus death for us, we should live for Him alongside other believers.

In light of the sacrifice of Jesus...

1. _____ **firm on your confession (vs. 23)**
 - A. The author of Hebrews argues that because Jesus' promises are faithful, we can hold fast and strong to our confession of faith without wavering.
 - B. How clear and firm are you in your confession of Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior?

2. _____ **one another up (vs. 24)**
 - A. We are to stir one another to love and good works - things that obey the commands of Jesus and Glorify God.
 - B. Who have you stirred up lately towards love and good works?

3. _____ **in church (vs. 25)**
 - A. We are to meet together and encourage one another as we see the day drawing near of the return of Jesus.
 - B. Are you meeting well enough to give and receive the encouragement of other Christians outside of your immediate family?
