Christ Our Sacrifice

Hebrews 10:1-17

Context - The Author of Hebrews has shown us that Jesus is better than angels (1:5-2:18), Moses (3:1-6), The Sabbath (3:7-4:14), The High Priest (4:14-9:28). Now he shows how Jesus is better than the Old Testament temple/tabernacle sacrifices.

Main idea - Jesus is the perfect sacrifice who through his death on the cross he has fully met our need, freeing us completely from sin, guilt, and shame.

As you view the sacrifice of Christ you must		
1.		the purpose of the law (vs. 1-9)
	Α.	The law, which are contained in the first five books of the Bible, shows us our need for Jesus Christ. It shows our sin and the holiness of God.
	B.	"The Mosaic law, with its priesthood, covenant, sacrifices, and tabernacle (cf. 7:11–9:28), can never make a person perfect since it is but a shadow of the true form, which is found in Christ and his final sacrifice." (ESV Study Bible)
2.		at the finished work of Christ (vs. 10-13)
		While the work of the High Priest never ends, and he continually stands to make intercession for Israel, the work of Christ is completed, and he has taken his seat at the right hand of the Father.
	D.	Christ is waiting for the moment to where all of his enemies should be made his footstool - when He will return and vanquish all evil.
3.		your total pardon (vs. 14-17)
	E.	Those who receive their pardon in Christ receive a full pardon, and God will remember "their sins and lawless deeds no more."

F. The death of Christ for sin is full and complete, and no more offering is needed.
