

## **The Five Solas: Soli Deo Gloria**

(For the Glory of God Alone)

### **Romans 11:33-36**

**Context** – In the book of Romans, Paul walks through God’s plan to save the world through His son Jesus. The entire book leads to this chapter where Paul discusses God’s heart to reach Gentiles (non Jews) and then to reach the Jews. After unwrapping God’s plan in eleven chapters, Paul finally breaks out in a praise of Doxology.

### **To Grow in Glorifying God...**

#### **1. \_\_\_\_\_ at His Grandeur (vs. 33)**

- A. Paul worships God for His: Wisdom, Knowledge, Omniscience, Judgments, and Ways.
- B. You can never exhaust the marvelous nature and grandeur of God.

#### **2. \_\_\_\_\_ on His Complexity (vs. 33b-35)**

- A. Here, Paul quotes Isaiah 40:13 and Job 41:11 to exult in the complexity of God’s ways.
- B. Have you found the complexity of God worthy of praise rather than a burden?

#### **3. \_\_\_\_\_ Him with your life (vs. 36)**

- A. Since all things are from God, and through God, and for God, it follows that He deserves all the Glory forever.
- B. Have you discovered the joy and fulfillment of bringing Glory to God?
