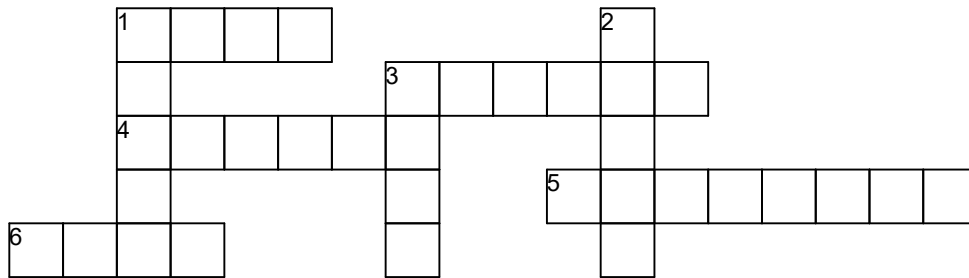


Jesus and the Sabbath
