## The Family of Jesus

Text: Mark 3:31-35

## **Context** -

After dealing with the many questions of the Scribes and Pharisees, Jesus makes clear exactly who his true family is.

Main Idea - Those who do the will of God are a part of Jesus' family.

When you study Jesus family
1 your doctrine (vs. 31-32) A. Many of us were raised with the non-biblical doctrine of the perpetual virginity of Mary, where she had no other children. B. The Bible makes clear in this passage and in many others that Mary had other sons and daughters. (See Acts 1:14 and Mark 6:3 as examples of this) C. Is your doctrine more shaped by the tradition of man or the revealed Word of God.
2 his true family (vs. 33-34) A. The true family of Jesus are not the sons of Abraham, nor the Scribes and Pharisees, nor the flesh and blood brothers and sisters of Jesus - but anyone who does the will of the Father. B. It is only in a relationship with God the Father through God the Son, Jesus Christ, that one can do the will of the Father. (Ephesians 2:10) See also Matthew 7:21-23. C. Are you a genuine part of the family of God in Jesus?
3 the will of God (vs. 35)
A. Since we can only do the will God through our relationship with Jesus, let us pursue that will wholeheartedly! (Romans 12:1-2, 1 Peter 4:2)

B. Are you pursuing the will of God in Christ?
