In what way does doing God's will make a person Christ's brother or sister? How has your commitment to Christ affected your relationship with your family?

Why is it important for us to place even our families under the rule and place of Christ?

In light of this passage, how should Christians relate to one another? How should you relate to members of your family who are not Christians?

When has your commitment to Christ caused conflict in your family? How do you think God wants you to respond to conflict situations in your family?

How can a person be sure to be included in the family of God?

What do Jesus' actions in this episode tell you about what your priorities in life should be?
