## **Faithful Parenting**

**Text:** Genesis 18:16-21

**Context -** Before the birth of Isaac, God was promising Abraham descendants and commanding Abraham to raise his children to follow God's commands.

**Main Idea -** With God's help, faithfully fulfill your calling as a parent to raise your children for the Glory of God.

#### From Abraham's faithfulness...

## 1) \_\_\_\_\_ your calling as parents (vs. 16-19a)

- A. Like Abraham, if you are a parent, God has chosen you to raise a child. God has also chosen what child(ren) will be placed in your care.
- B. As a Christian parent, you have been entrusted with a stewardship to raise your child for the glory of God.

## 2) \_\_\_\_\_\_ your children to keep the way of the Lord (vs. 19b)

- A. The example in Genesis of Abraham showing his children the way of the Lord, was that he would construct an altar for worship wherever they traveled.
- B. The altar would teach 4 things: 1. God is Holy 2. Man is Sinful 3. Our sins separate us from God 4. Innocent blood must be shed for guilty blood.
- C. Altars in Genesis: 1. God in the garden of Eden (Genesis 3:21) 2. Cain and Abel (Genesis 4:1-5) 3. Noah after the flood (Genesis 8:20) 4.
  Abraham in Shechem (Genesis 12:7), Bethel (Genesis 12:8) and Hebron (Genesis 13:18) 5. Isaac in Beer-sheba (Genesis 26:25) 6. Jacob in Bethel (Genesis 35:1-2)

# 3) \_\_\_\_\_\_ a life of righteousness and Justice (vs. 19c-22)

- A. Righteousness and justice come from God and characterize the people of God. Without God, there will be no bearings of right and wrong.
- B. For the Christian, our righteousness is found only in Christ and His righteousness. Our justice is found only in Christ and His justice.
