What actions made Abraham successful in passing down the worship of God in his home?

What actions can you perform to successfully pass down the worship of God in your own home?

How important is living a life of righteousness and justice?

As America is currently experiencing an erosion of the Christian family, what specific actions can parents perform to disciple their children other than bringing them to church?

Do you think that it is wrong for a parent to force his/her children to attend church?

What are some ways you can influence your children/grandchildren for Christ?
