

## Jesus Does Everything Well

**Text:** Mark 7:31-37

**Context** - Mark interrupts his section of the ministry of Jesus with two healings that involve Gentiles: 1. The woman's possessed daughter (Mark 7:24-30) 2. And now the Deaf man of Decapolis.

**Main Idea** - Jesus does everything well.

**Because Jesus does everything well...**

**1. \_\_\_\_\_ all challenges to Him (vs. 31-32)**

- A. Friends of this deaf man brought him to Jesus and begged Jesus to heal the man.
- B. There is only one solution to the sinful and broken world problems that we and our friends face - the Lord Jesus Christ.

**2. \_\_\_\_\_ his miraculous power (vs. 33-35)**

- A. In a unique and personal way, Jesus heals the man where his ears were opened and he immediately begins to speak clearly.
- B. Jesus can heal and still heals today. The best miracle he performs is the miracle of conversion.

**3. \_\_\_\_\_ his power to all (vs. 36-37)**

- A. While Jesus's other healing miracles brought astonishment and amazement (1:22, 27; 2:12; 5:20, 42; 6:2, 6, 51), this is the only time that "extremely" or "beyond all measure" appears. He has done everything well echoes the Septuagint wording of Gn 1:31. Once again, Jesus had done what only God could do (Ex 4:11) (CSB Study Bible)
- B. Who do you know who needs the power and presence of Jesus in their lives? What can you do to get them to Jesus?
