- 4. How did Jesus limit Himself? (2:6–8)
- 5. How was Christ fully God and fully man at the same time? (2:6–8)
- 6. How is Christ the best example of humility and unselfishness for us? (2:6-8)
- 7. Why did Christ take on the limitations of being human even though He was of the same nature as God? (2:7)
- 8. How did God the father exalt Jesus, God the Son? (2:9)
- 9. How did Christ win sovereignty over all people and over everything? (2:10)
- 10. What confession will every person make? (2:11)
- 11. What kind of disposition does Christ want us to have?
- 12. How does Christ's example of humility challenge our natural selfcenteredness?
- 13. What practical steps can you take this week to demonstrate humility in your relationships?
- 14. For the sake of unity in Christ, what petty squabbles should you clear up right away? How?
- 15. What would happen in our relationships if we lived out Philippians 2:5– 11? How can you go from being a "grasper" to a "giver"?
- 16. How is Jesus' model of leadership different from a worldly view of leadership? How can you put this type of life in practice today?
