- 4. Do Paul's instructions to the rich have an application to those we might consider to be (financially) lower or middle-class in our culture? Explain.
- 5. What does Paul mean by "the uncertainty of wealth" in verse 17?
- 6. Does Paul condemn wealth? If not, how does he instruct the rich to view their wealth?
- 7. Why should those who are rich not be arrogant or put their hope in wealth? (6:17)
- 8. What command is given to those who are rich? (6:18)
- 9. Why would someone want to lay up treasure for themselves? (6:19)
- 10. Why is it so easy for us to trust in our possessions, accomplishments, or abilities?
- 11. In what ways do people place their treasure here on earth?
- 12. How can a person lay up treasure in heaven?
