The Return of Christ

Mark 13:14-26

Context: During the week before Jesus dies on the cross, Jesus shares with his disciples the unfolding events of the end of the world.

As Jesus teaches on the end times...

I. _____ the Tribulation (vs. 14-23)

- A. The Abomination of Desolation is described in detail in the Old Testament book of Daniel (9:27; 11:31; 12:11) and in the New Testament in 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12 and 1 John 2:18. It refers to a desecration of the Jewish Temple by the Antichrist.
- B. While there are diverse views on interpreting these passages, many scholars believe that when the Antichrist appears, a period of great tribulation will unfold on the earth.

II. _____ His coming return (vs. 24-31)

- A. At some point after a time of tribulation, Christ will return and consummate the end of the age bringing judgment on the world.
- B. There is a great mystery in scripture as to the timing of the return of Jesus. This uncertainty has led to many diverse views today as to when Christ might return.
- C. Whatever view you hold to, all Christians need to maintain a humility towards an imminent return of Jesus that Jesus could return at any moment.

III. _____ awake (vs. 32-36)

- A. Four times in the closing verses of Mark 14 (vs. 33a; 34b, 35a, & 37b) we are told to "Stay Awake." This means to be on guard, to watch and be alert and look for the approaching signs.
- B. We must all live as if His return could come today.
