Jesus Prays in Gethsemane

Mark 14:32-42

Context: During the final evening of Jesus, after the Last Supper, Jesus goes to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane to prepare for the cross.

As we watch Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane...

I. _____ the agony of the cup (vs. 32-36a)

- A. The "cup" represents all the wrath and hatred of God against sin. The "cup" symbolized the full, undiluted wrath of God that was about to be poured out on Jesus.
- B. Psalm 75:8 (ESV) For in the hand of the Lord there is a cup with foaming wine, well mixed, and he pours out from it, and all the wicked of the earth shall drain it down to the dregs.
- C. Isaiah 51:17 (ESV) Wake yourself, wake yourself, stand up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk from the hand of the Lord the cup of his wrath, who have drunk to the dregs the bowl, the cup of staggering.

II. _____ his full surrender to the Father (vs. 36b)

- A. In His humanity, Jesus was sorrowful and asked the Father to "remove the cup" of suffering wrath for sin and sinners.
- B. Just as he had done throughout His entire life, Jesus submitted to the will of the Heavenly Father in His moment of anguish before enduring the cross.

III. _____ awake and pray (vs. 37-42)

- A. While Jesus is praying and wrestling with the greatest load any man ever tried to carry, the disciples are asleep.
- B. Well-intentioned believers can easily fail to fulfill their calling by merely giving in to various physical needs or desires. (ESV Study Bible)
