#### The Resurrection of Jesus

Mark 16

**Context**: After his death and burial, the followers of Jesus show up at his tomb and find it empty.

### What are we to make of Mark 16:9-20 and other passages like it?

- 1) God is sovereign over His Word.
- 2) The Bible is 100% Accurate
- 3) These sections do not contradict anything elsewhere in Scripture
- 4) To build doctrines solely upon them, or upon any isolated portions of scripture is dangerous.

### As Jesus dies for your sins and is buried...

## I. \_\_\_\_\_ the women approach the tomb (vs. 1-4)

A. The same women who were at the cross are now bringing spices for anointing to the tomb of Jesus. "That the women came to anoint Jesus' body on the third day after His burial showed that they, like the disciples, were not expecting Him to rise from the dead." John MacArthur

## II. \_\_\_\_\_ into the empty tomb (vs. 5-6)

A. The angel confirms to the women that Jesus had risen from the dead just as he predicted in Mark 8:31; 9:9, 31; 10:32–34; 14:25).

# III. \_\_\_\_\_ the message of the resurrection with everybody (v.s. 7-20)

- A. The rest of the chapter has the women and the disciples spreading the message of the resurrection to everybody:
  - 1. "Go, tell the disciples." Vs. 7.
  - 2. Mary tells the other women and disciples. Vs. 10.
  - 3. Two disciples meet Jesus and tell the other disciples. Vs. 13.
  - 4. All disciples are now commanded to "Go into all the world and proclaim the gospel to the whole creation." Vs. 15.
  - 5. The disciples go out and preach everywhere. Vs. 20.
