- A. Cataclysmic Origin The Big Bang Scientist Francis Collins, in his book The Language of God: "We have this very solid conclusion that the universe had an origin, the Big Bang....And the very fact that the universe had a beginning implies that someone was able to begin it. And it seems to me that had to be outside of nature."
- B. Conditions for Life "For organic life to exist, the fundamental regularities and constants of physics—the speed of light, the gravitational constant, the strength of the weak and strong nuclear forces—must all have values that together fall into an extremely narrow range. The probability of this perfect calibration happening by chance is so tiny as to be statistically negligible." Tim Keller The Reason for God.
