## The Holy Spirit - His Work and Role

John 16:5-15 (The Holy Spirit Discourses of John 14-16 Series #4)

**Context:** This passage shows up in the Farewell Discourse of Jesus in John (13-20). These words are instructions for all of Jesus' disciples before he went to the cross. In John 14-16, Jesus specifically teaches on the Holy Spirit.

## As you observe the role of the Holy Spirit...

- A. \_\_\_\_\_ His work in the World (vs. 5-11)
  - 1. He convicts of sin.
  - 2. He reveals righteousness.
  - 3. He warns of judgment.
- B. \_\_\_\_\_ His work in us (vs. 12-14a)
  - 1. He guides into truth.
  - 2. He warns of things to come.
- C. \_\_\_\_\_ the person and mission of Jesus (vs. 14-15)
  - 1. The Holy Spirit's role is to glorify the Son, receiving the Son's words and disclosing them to his followers (16:14). Once again we see the Trinity in action in that the Son took revelation from the Father and would declare it to his disciples through the Holy Spirit (16:15).
  - 2. Even further than just declaring the truth of Jesus to us, the Holy Spirit makes certain that all the revelation bound up in Jesus' person and mission are pressed home on His disciples.
