

## **The Holy Spirit - Our Teacher**

John 14:25-27 (The Holy Spirit Discourses of John 14-16 Series #2)

**Context:** This passage shows up in the Farewell Discourse of Jesus in John (13-20). These words are instructions for all of Jesus' disciples before he went to the cross. In John 14-16, Jesus specifically teaches on the Holy Spirit.

### **The Holy Spirit helps us to...**

#### **A. \_\_\_\_\_ the teachings (vs. 26a)**

1. A. There are many ways in which the Holy Spirit delights in teaching you scripture:
  - a) Invitation - Sense the Holy Spirit inviting you to spend time with God.
  - b) Inspiration - All Scripture is Inspired
  - c) Illumination - Some scripture is especially interesting in the moment.

#### **B. \_\_\_\_\_ what Jesus spoke. (Vs. 26b)**

1. **Scripture memory is very useful here. There are many ways in which the Holy Spirit can use Scripture in our lives:**
  - a) Discernment - When the Holy Spirit speaks a passage that give light to a person or situation.
  - b) Encouragement - When the Holy Spirit gives a burden verse to share with someone else.
  - c) Exhortation - When the Holy Spirit brings up scripture to charge or challenge someone.

#### **C. \_\_\_\_\_ in the Peace of Christ (vs. 27)**

1. Peace is a part of the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22)
2. Peace abides with the Christian and guards thoughts and feelings. (Philippians 4:6-7)
3. Romans 8:6 - "Now the mindset of the flesh is death, but the mindset of the Spirit is life and peace." (See also Romans 14:17)
