III. _____ the Fulfillment (vs. 17-20)

- **A.** As the children of Israel were preparing to enter the promised land, Moses included this section of scripture to remind them that their forefather Abraham paid for legal title to this burial ground because he believed what God had promised. Abraham had faith in God's promise to give the land of Canaan to their descendants.
- **B.** This purchase of land and a cave within the promised land was the first acquisition of Abraham and his people. His descendants would inhabit the land 400 years later. As you grieve the loss of a loved one, continue to meditate on the unfolding promises of God.
